Robert Buckner started the first National Student Chapter for NABCJ at Langston University. He was used by the National Board to help organize other Student Chapters across the country. He served as a mentor to many students and NABCJ members. He was a great athletic and was inducted into Langston Athletic Hall of Fame for Basketball. Mr. Buckner was part of the original group that founded the Oklahoma Chapter of NABCJ, becoming the organization first president. He was the last Superintendent for the Boys Detention center in Boley before it was closed. He also served as the Superintendent for the Taft Boy's Detention Center.
